Whayne Award for Graduate Student Service

This \$250 award is given annually to a graduate student in their second through fourth year of study who has demonstrated excellence in service to the department, the field, and/or university during the academic year for which the prize is awarded. The award is selected by the Elementary Language Instruction Committee and does not require the student to submit any materials.

Eligibility

- Currently in second through fourth year of graduate study in the Department of Hispanic Studies
- Has not previously won the Whayne Award for Graduate Student Service

Selection criteria:

- Demonstrated excellence in service to the department and/or university as evidenced by leadership experience and effectiveness, support provided to departmental initiatives and programs, service in committees, and/or other related efforts.
- Participation and engagement with programs, initiatives, and other efforts that demonstrate citizenship and support the life of the department and the field overall.
- Note, administrative work for which a student receives any sort of compensation, e.g., a
 course release or stipend, will not be considered as service, such as serving as the
 graduate assistant to the ,director of KFLC.
